PC-PNDT ACT

The meeting with Hon. Union Health Minister in July 2012 was fruitful as we were able to put forth all the issues successfully. The Hon. Union Health Minister gave a patient hearing to all the issues. Thanks to the efforts of all our team members Dr. Rajeev Yeravadekar, Dr. Nozer Sheriar, Dr. Girija Wagh, Dr. Gayatri Thakkar and myself.

Following important decisions were taken

1. Sending directives to the state governments that the Gynecologists can do USG as per the law and do not need additional experience certificates.
2. Committee appointed to modify F form & make online submission simpler.
3. Code of conduct to be observed by Appropriate Authorities during inspections & sealing of machines. (directions to be given)
4. Need for graded punishment was agreed upon in principle but as it will require change in the law itself; decided to work on initiation of such a process.
5. The state Appropriate Authorities will also be directed not to target Medical Termination of Pregnancies as it is detrimental to women's rights & spirit of the MTP law.
6. Process to detect unauthorized machines & centers will be further strengthened.
7. On our side we have promised full cooperation in pointing out the culprits who carry out sex determination whether they are our members or any one in our vicinity that we may come across or hear about.

Friends, since the Hon Union Health Minister & the CSB have responded very positively to our demands; onus is also upon us to set up serious mechanisms to help in implementation of this law in letter & spirit.

I am thankful to my colleagues in the CSB and all of you more than 150 who have responded with various documents & suggestions which were of great help.

I am aware that problems already faced by some of our colleagues are not immediately solved but now we have solid grounds on which to act.

I promise you on behalf of all of us & our mother organization FOGSI including all the office bearers that we will not be found wanting in our further endeavors.

A panel discussion on "Myths & Facts about rational use of blood & management of fluid & electrolyte imbalance" was lucidly conducted.
