EDITORIAL

WHEN HEALERS BECOME TARGETS



The relationship between society and its healthcare professionals is built on a simple yet profound understanding: when illness strikes, doctors will be there. Yet, despite the vital role they play, incidents of violence against healthcare workers continue to cast a shadow over the medical profession.

The recent assault on doctors by patients' relatives in Udaipur is a deeply disturbing reminder of a growing challenge facing healthcare systems across the country. Such incidents are not isolated acts of aggression; they represent a breakdown of trust and respect that are essential for effective healthcare delivery.

In any civilized society, those who serve the public must be able to do so without fear for their safety. PGT IN IVF

INTRODUCTION

There is a constant trend of rising infertility in India due to the present lifestyle of our population. At present 15 to 20 percent of the Indian population requires some sort of ART assistance. In the present era of technological advancements, IVF has a great role to play in helping infertile couples. With the present advancements, we are able to achieve almost 60 to 65 percent results. The science of IVF is a bit submerged one in general public.

WHAT IS PGT?

PGT (Pre Implantation Genetic testing) is a technique through which we can select best embryos which are genetically and chromosomally normal and then implant into the uterus. As the embryos are genetically normal, the chances of implantation increase by 20 to 25 percent.

INDICATIONS OF PGT IN IVF

PGT is one of the advanced test offered to the couples in IVF. This test is not for all and there are very specific indications of PGT. They are as follows:

1. Advanced maternal age (more than 35 years)
2. Recurrent pregnancy loss (more than 2 early or late abortions)
3. Recurrent implantation failure
4. Severe male infertility
5. History of any genetic disorder running in the family

TECHNIQUE OF PERFORMING PGT

PGT can be performed by invasive and non invasive technique. In the invasive one, we take a laser biopsy of the day 5 embryo (blastocyst) and send the biopsy to the genetic lab for analysis. In the non invasive technique, we

take the surrounding culture media of the embryo and send that media to the genetic lab for analysis. The non invasive technique has no chance of embryo injury as compared to the invasive technique where there are 15 to 20 percent chances of embryo degeneration after the biopsy.

TYPES OF PGT:

PGTA: It analyse chromosomal numerical abnormalities

PGT SR : Analyse the structural abnormalities like translocations , inversions and duplications in the embryo.

PGT M : Formerly known as PGT-D which analyse the single gene defects like those in cystic fibrosis , neurofibromatosis , tay sachs disease , sickle cell anemia , thalassemia , and X linked disorders like Hemophilia , fragile X syndrome and most of the neuromuscular atrophies.

LIMITATION

PGT provides significant advantages but it also comes with some limitations and ethical considerations. These include the cost of the procedure, potential false positives or negatives, and the ethical debates surrounding embryo selection and genetic screening. Additionally, it's important to recognize that PGT is not foolproof and may not guarantee a healthy pregnancy or child.

CONCLUSION

PGT in IVF is a powerful tool that can improve reproductive outcomes and prevent genetic disorders, but it requires careful consideration and counselling to ensure it aligns with the specific needs and values of the patients involved.

INTRODUCTION

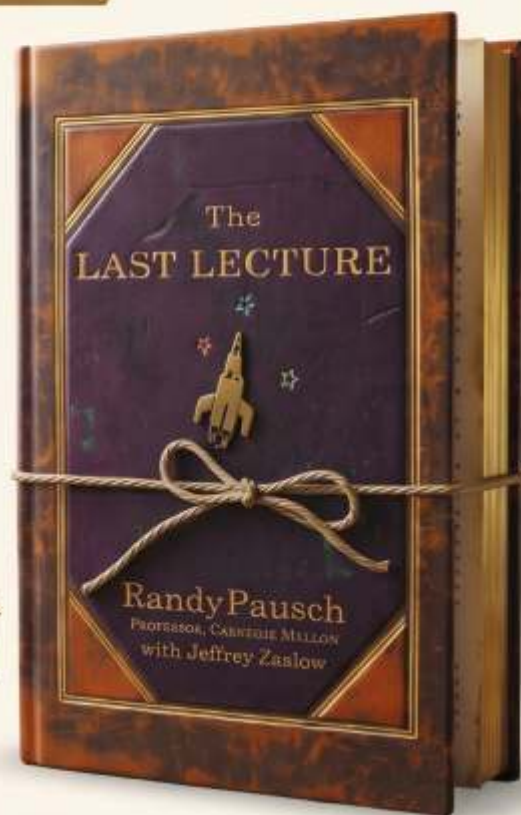

In 2007, after being diagnosed with terminal pancreatic cancer, Pausch delivered a lecture titled “Really Achieving Your Childhood Dreams,” which quickly gained worldwide attention for its optimism, wisdom, and authenticity.

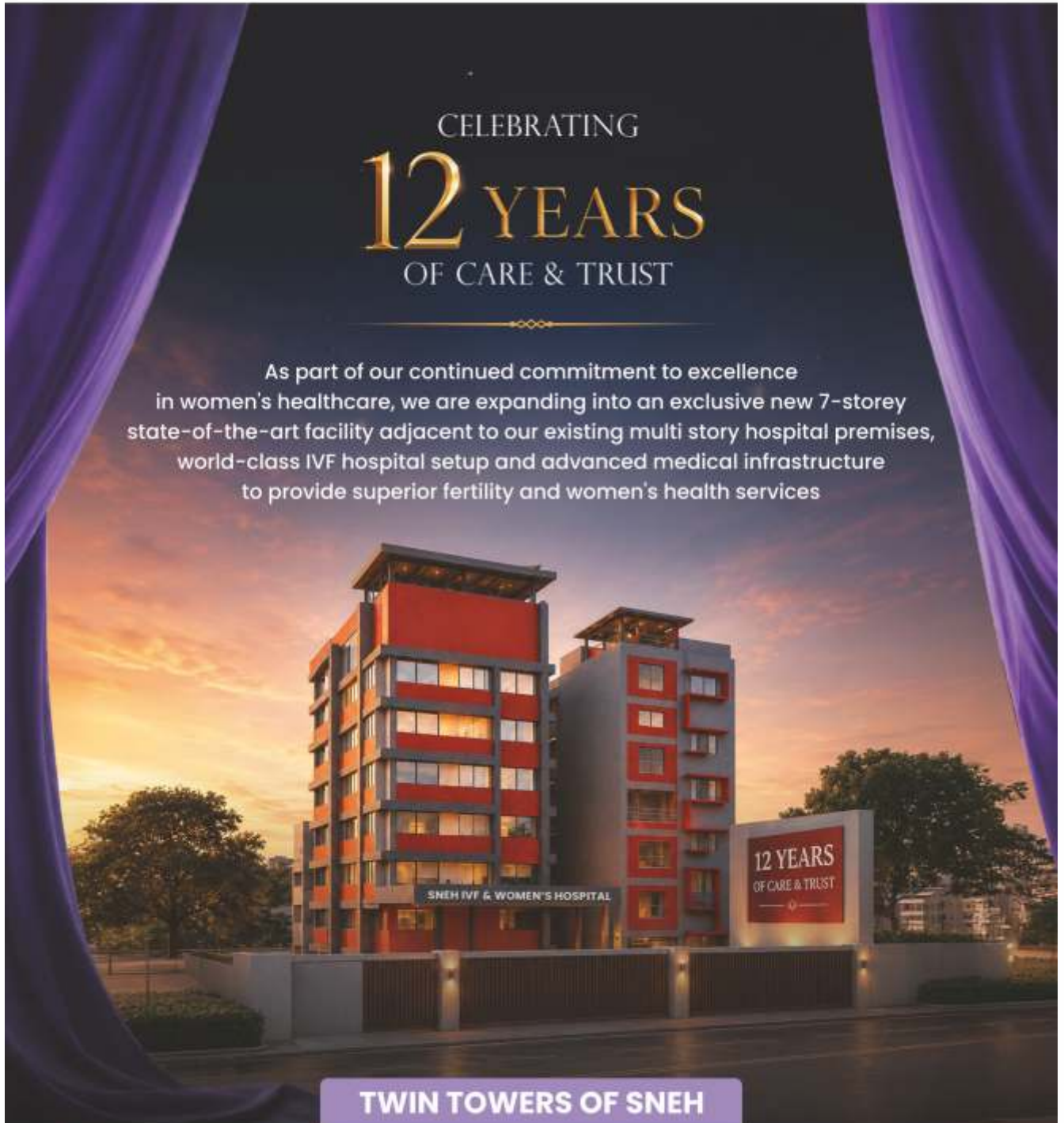
